

RNEA Committees

Negotiations: Huge time commitment, especially in the winter. Meetings weekly, some lengthy.

Negotiations Support: Can be one job, or several. Work may include tabulating surveys, writing, clerical, making phone calls, research, attending meetings.

Political Action and School Board Elections: Opportunities for a variety of activities and levels of involvement. School Board screening committee needed to interview candidates and make recommendations to the membership, two-three meetings. Each school needs a school board election contact for the spring elections. RNEA school board campaign committee needed to coordinate activities. Also, assistance is needed for state legislative political action and fundraising. State activities include: attending Lobby Day in Jefferson City, serving on screening committees for state legislative candidates, working for endorsed candidates.

Rapid Response Team: Committee meets only when action is needed on important issues. Duties could include running phone trees, publicity, etc.

Tell Tale: Editors and/or people willing to help out occasionally. Approximate time commitment 1-2 hours every other week.

Membership: Committee to be formed in the spring to develop fall membership drive and training for BRs.

RNEA Nominations: Committee needed in January/February to accept nominations, create ballot, and count votes for RNEA offices. Anyone running for office is disqualified from serving on this committee.

RNEA Scholarship: Committee develops and sends out RNEA scholarship form, and judges candidates for child of member scholarship. Approximate time commitment: 2-4 hours, 1-3 meetings, March.

MLK Poster Contest/Law Day Essay Contest: Sends out information about these contests, collects and judges entries. MLK Poster Contest Jan-Feb., Law Day Essay Contest March-April. Approximate time commitment: 2-4 hours, 1-2 meetings for each.

RNEA Budget: Committee evaluates past programs and budget and formulates a proposed budget which is presented to the BRs and Exec. Board for approval. Committee meets in the spring, 2-4 hours.

Social: Help is needed in planning possible tournaments, happy hours, occasional nights out and/or etc.
